Members of the Board serve for terms of six years, with the terms of three members expiring on January 31 of each odd-numbered year.

STATEMENT OF OFFICER AND OATH OF OFFICE

Newly appointed Trustees shall sign and file with the Secretary of State the required Statement of Appointed Officer issued by the Office of the Governor. After the statement has been filed, and before entering upon the duties of the office, the Trustees shall take the oath, or affirmation of office, and shall file it with the Secretary of State. *Education Code 11.061; Tex. Const. Art. XVI, Sec. 1*

The oath may be administered and a certificate of the fact given by:

- 1. A judge, clerk, or commissioner of any court of record;
- 2. A notary public;
- 3. A justice of the peace, or a clerk of a justice court;
- 4. The Secretary of State of Texas;
- 5. A member of the State Legislature;
- 6. The Lieutenant Governor of Texas;
- 7. The Governor of Texas.
