BOARD INTERNAL ORGANIZATION: INTERNAL COMMITTEES

IN GENERAL

The President of the Board may from time to time, as he or she deems necessary, create committees to facilitate the efficient operation of the Board. He or she shall name one or more board members and appoint other persons as he or she deems necessary; along with naming a person to serve as the chair of each committee.

A committee that includes less than a quorum of Board members is not subject to the Open Meetings Act if it serves a purely advisory function. Any committee that conducts public business shall post an agenda that complies with the Texas Open Meetings Act.

COMMITTEE APPOINTMENTS

Committee work shall be done by standing committees and special committees. Standing committees shall be the Policy Committee and the Budget and Audit Committee. Special committees may be created by the President of the Board for specific assignments. Such committees shall terminate upon completion of their assignments. The President of the Board and the Superintendent shall be ex-officio members of each special committee.

Members of all committees shall be appointed by the President.

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
