**STUDENT RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:
MARRIED STUDENTS**

TSD students who are married shall have the same rights and responsibilities as unmarried students to participate in the programs and services of the school. This includes the right to participate in any extra-curricular activities on the same basis, and subject to the same requirements, as unmarried students.

The School shall not apply any rule concerning a student's actual or potential marital status that treats students differently on the basis of sex. 20 U.S.C. 1681; 34 CFR 106.40

Except as expressly provided by law, a student who has been married in accordance with Texas law has the capacity and power of an adult, regardless of age. Family Code 1.104
